Creating

1 Generate and Conceptualize Artistic Ideas and Work K.MU:CR1

- 1 The creative ideas, concepts, and feelings that influence musicians' work emerge from a variety of sources. K.MU:CR1.1

4 Select, Analyze, and Interpret Artistic Work for Presentation K.MU:PR4

- 1 Performers' interest in and knowledge of musical works, understanding of their own technical skill, and the context for a performance influence the selection of repertoire. K.MU:PR4.1
 - a With guidance, demonstrate and state personal interest in varied musical selections. K.MU:PR4.1.A
 - 2 Analyzing creators' context and how they manipulate elements of music provides insight into their intent and informs performance. K.MU:PR4.2
 - a With guidance, explore and demonstrate awareness of music contrasts such as high/low, loud/soft, and same/different in a variety of music selected for performance. K.MU:PR4.2.A
 - 3 Performers make interpretive decisions based on their understanding of context and expressive intent. K.MU:PR4.3
