Creating

1: Generate and conceptualize artistic ideas and work.

- a. Compose rhythmic, melodic, and harmonic phrases over harmonic accompaniments within a given form(s) that convey expressive intent. MU:CR1.1.6.A
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2: Organize and develop artistic ideas and work.
